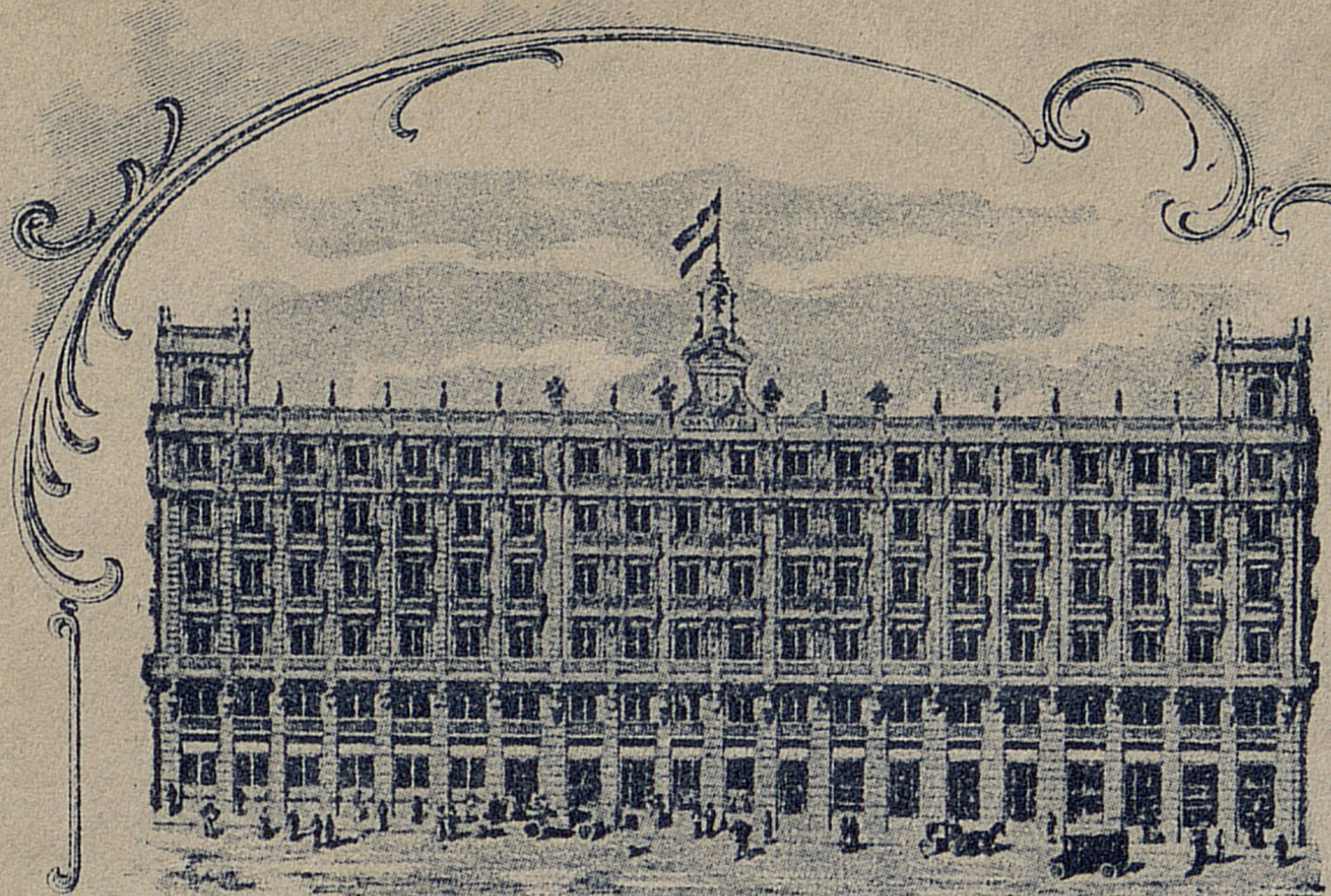

Dear Professor Cartailhac:

After a short tour in southern Spain I shall visit the paleolithic caverns of Santander. From Santander I shall go to Toulouse ^{via} Hendaye, Avenignan ^{and} Salies du Salat.
